Renal Medication Therapy Management for High Risk ESRD Patients

Davita Rx

High-Risk, End-Stage Renal Disease

These data were originally presented at the National Kidney Foundation Spring Clinical Meeting, Orlando, FL, April 18-22, 2017.

Patients with end stage renal disease (ESRD) take an average of 20-22 prescription medications or approximately 19 pills per day, possess lower medication adherence rates (PDC) compared to other patient populations, and are at increased risk for medication-related problems (MRPs).

Patients with ESRD also have increased rates of hospitalization, particularly for heart failure and infections compared with persons without CKD. Additionally, ESRD patients who have recently been discharged from the hospital are at high risk for subsequent hospital admissions.

MRPs are increasingly being recognized as a possible contributing factor for poor outcomes among patients with ESRD, and recent estimates suggest that 2.4% to 4.1% of all hospitalizations may be related to adverse drug events and poor medication adherence. Furthermore, a high proportion of adverse drug events (up to 69%) may be preventable.

DaVita Rx renal MTM program was formulated specifically for high risk patients (defined as discharged within 30 days with ESRD and/or filled renal pharmacist to address common medication related problems such as drug-drug interactions, duplicate therapies, dose optimization and others. The program consists of three steps: medication reconciliation, pharmacist medication review and issue resolution.

The study population included four groups of recently discharged ESRD patients enrolled in several California-based special need plans (SNPs). A total of 1,223 patients were analyzed in this meta-study: 475 patients who received a DaVita Rx renal-pharmacist medication review and 748 who did not. This meta-study combines the results from 4 different studies grouped into four cohorts, and when combined, the result is statistically significant.

DaVita Rx MTM Program for High-Risk ESRD Patients

The DaVita Rx MTM program is a pharmacist-driven intervention, designed to address potential drug therapy problems in high-risk ESRD patients.

For the patient cohorts analyzed here, high-risk status was designated on the basis of recent hospital discharge. The medication review is conducted in three discrete steps: Medication Reconciliation, Medication Review, and Issue Resolution.

A youth-led, youth-run organization, the Scouts are trained to be leaders. Scouts provide direction, coaching, and training that empowers others with the skills to lead. The Miami Valley Council operates two year-round facilities: Cricket Hiller and Woodland Trails, where Scouts safely practice their leadership skills in our "classrooms in the woods."

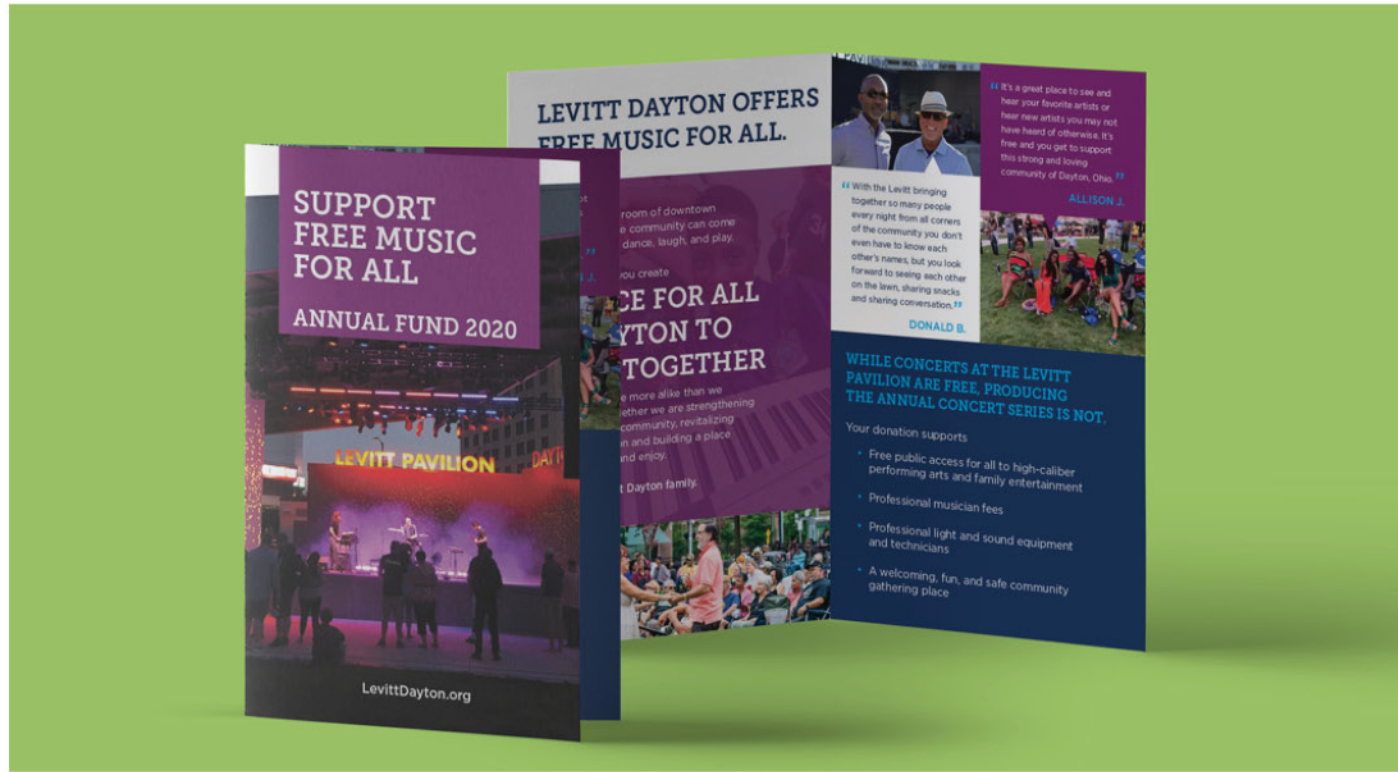
